KCMEA INSTRUMENTAL/VOCAL PRIVATE LESSON SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships are awarded annually to promising local students in **grades 6-11**. The purpose of the scholarship is to provide lessons to qualified students who have not had the opportunity to study privately due to financial need.

Students awarded a scholarship for private lessons are expected to participate in the school band, choir or orchestra for at least one additional year.

The Kern County Music Educators Association (KCMEA) sponsors this scholarship. A committee selected by the Executive Board will serve as the judging panel. The scholarships will cover approximately 6-8 private lessons, not to exceed \$175. **Donations to the scholarship fund, or donation of private lessons are welcome and encouraged.** Donations are tax deductible (checks made payable to KCMEA).

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. The student is currently performing with the school band, choir or orchestra.
- 2. The students have been a member of the ensemble for at least one year.
- 3. The student has never had the opportunity to study privately due to financial need.
- 4. The student displays a promising interest and talent, and would benefit from private instruction.
- 5. School music instructors who are current members of KCMEA may nominate up to two students.
- 6. Scholarship applicants must have demonstrated financial need. Verification is the responsibility of the nominating teacher.
